Like other forms of white collar crimes, identity theft can occur from the suspect obtaining information such as name, date of birth, social social security number, health insurance information, or other personal identifying information. Use the only credit report system authorized by the US Government, and running this report will not affect your credit. You are provided by law one report from each credit bureau once a year. I recommend that you run one credit report every 4 months.

## See If You've Been Compromised:


